Winston Hill White Zinfandel 1 £19.95
Italy
 A fantastic example of an off-dry, easy drinking wine full of summer fruit flavours with a hint of sweetness.

Torre Alta Pinot Grigio Rosé 1 £19.50
Italy
 A pale and delicate Rosé with beautiful soft strawberry flavours, nuances of nectarine and perfumed floral notes.

Ormilles Rosé, Côtes de Provence 1 £20.95
South of France
 A light, dry and fruity rosé, with strawberry, nectarine and watermelon accompanied by a delicate juiciness.

Dessert Wine

Elysium Black Muscat, Half bottle 7 £22.00
California
 Virtually black in colour, with a rose-like aroma, very intense on the palate and full of fantastic rich velvety fruit.

Royal Tokaji Late Harvest, Half Bottle 8 £21.50
Hungary
 Straw yellow in colour, with golden highlights. Aromas of white flowers, peach, apricots and quince carry through to a palate of more ripe stone fruits and dried fig flavours.

Codorníu Brut NV 1 £20.50
Spain
 A dry, light-bodied Cava displaying green apple, citrus, almond and brioche characters.

Prosecco Corte Alta 2 £21.95
Italy
 Delicate and aromatic with fine bubbles. This wine carries lots of fresh peach, pear and an elegant zest.


J de Telmont Grande Réserve 1 £35.00
Champagne
 One of the few remaining, family owned Champagne houses, De Telmont produces this excellent non-vintage in a medium bodied, soft and fruity, classically yeasty style. Fabulous value.

Bouvet Saumur Rosé Brut 1 £22.95
Loire
 A delicate and inviting salmon pink, this is a light and immediately welcoming sparkling rosé, with a raspberry and peach fruit character, a fine mousse and a clean and uplifting floral nose.

Bollinger Special Cuvée 1 £60.00
Champagne
 Bollinger is made from first-run juice only, and the majority of vineyards used have Premier and Grand Cru status, resulting in a full-bodied Champagne of great class. Delightful pale gold in colour, the mousse is light and persistent.

Laurent-Perrier Rosé 1 £75.00
Champagne
 Unusually made by the saignée method, with plenty of stylish strawberry fruit, full of vivacity and easy-drinking charm. A wonderfully refreshing apéritif, it also works well with a variety of dishes.

Dom Perignon, Gift Box 1 £145.00
 Exceptional depth, rich texture and great ageing potential characterises this iconic Champagne from Moët et Chandon, named after the Benedictine monk who pioneered Champagne.

Alfredini Garganega Pinot Grigio 1 £19.50
Italy
 Light and refreshing. Faint hints of stone fruit, joined by flavours of lemon, lime and a honeyed edge.
 175ml £4.60 250ml £6.50

Five Foot Track Chardonnay 2 £18.25
Australia
 This is a soft and rounded wine, with characteristics of cooked apple and underlying notes of vanilla.
 175ml £4.45 250ml £6.20

Viña Carrasco Sauvignon Blanc 1 £18.25
Chile
 Bursting full with grass, elderflower and gooseberry flavours, this is a youthful and invigorating white.

L'abeille Picpoul De Pinet 1 £20.50
South of France
 A youthful white wine full of lively lemon fruit and lime zest flavours. Bright and vibrant
 175ml £4.90 250ml £6.80

Fathoms Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough 1 £21.95
New Zealand
 This wine springs from the glass, offering plumes of gooseberry, mango, blackcurrant leaf and elderflower.

Leeuwenkuil Chenin Blanc 2 £20.00
South Africa
 This is an elegant and refined wine with a racy acidity that adds freshness to the apple and tropical fruit flavours and the mineral finish.

Baron de Baussac Viognier 2 £20.50
South of France
 A fleshy white, with bright aromas of ripe apricot and peach, hints of grapefruit and fresh pineapple.

If you like Sauvignon Blanc try this

El Cante Albariño, Rías Baixas 1 £24.95
Spain
 Nectarine, apricot and peach are in perfect balance with a zesty and well defined citrus backbone.

Peter Lehmann Riesling, Eden Valley 2 £22.95
Australia
 Delightful citrus and stone fruit notes abound on the palate and the finish is remarkably taut. A mouth-watering acidity and limestone minerality leave the mouth feeling revitalised.

The Ned Pinot Grigio, Marlborough 1 £22.95
New Zealand
 A nose of pear drop, blossom and nectarine leading to a palate that is softer, richer and more tropical in flavour than its European counterpart. Lovely purity of fruit with a smooth finish.

Montagny, Grand Vin De Bourgogne, Buxy 1 £27.00
Burgundy
 This Chardonnay offers ripe lemon aromas, accompanied by subtle hints of white blossom, with an elegant, dry finish.

Sancerre Blanc, Berthier 1 £28.00
Loire
 Aromas of grapefruit and gooseberry leap from the glass, along with hints of lime, chalk and flint.

Chablis, Domaine de Chantemerle, Boudin 1 £35.00
Burgundy, France
 Hints of green apple, lime and citrus as well as warm ripe stone fruits, almost moving into tropical aromas. A weightier palate than usual, with stone fruits, citrus fruits and medium levels of acidity.

Red Wine

Five Foot Track Shiraz C £18.25
Australia
 A pleasing balance between ripe fruit and savoury, earthy notes. This wine is succulent with lashings of bramble fruit.

Viña Carrasco Merlot C £18.95
Chile
 Offers good concentration and depth of fruit, with a soft and plummy texture, and hints of vanilla.
 175ml £4.50 250ml £6.25

Aires Andinos Malbec D £18.75
Argentina
 Black fruits of the forest and mocha notes leap from the glass in this soft and supple expression of Malbec.
 175ml £4.70 250ml £6.60

Porcupine Ridge Syrah Viognier D £20.95
Western Cape, South Africa
 Slightly perfumed with aromas of ripe juicy plum and black berries, rich and smooth on the palate with rich plum flavours, some spice and floral notes.
 175ml £5.35 250ml £6.95

Oltre Passo Primitivo C £20.50
Italy
 Flavours of dried prune, date and plump cherry, with swathes of sweet spice. A mouth coating, chocolatey red wine.

A great red for summer

St Desir Pinot Noir C £20.50
French regions
 Showing violets and sweet red berries on the nose the palate is light, velvety and intricate, with integrated toasted notes.



Ribero del Duero, El Quintanal C £22.95
Ribero del Duero
 A full bodied, powerful red. This example is brimming with stewed dark fruits and integrated sweet spice.



Beefsteak Club Malbec, Mendoza D £22.95
Argentina
 Deep and vibrant Malbec with an intense nose of plum, damson and dark chocolate aromas. Lush and layered on the palate, with well-integrated oak and plenty of fine tannins.

Fleurie, Georges Duboeuf A £24.95
Beaujolais
 Classic Fleurie with fresh cherry fruits and a fragrant, floral perfume. Concentrated fruit and light tannic presence are testament to the cru status of this wine. An attractive wine with a silky texture.

Valpolicella Classico Superiore Ripasso, La Casetta B £27.95
Italy
 A beautiful deep ruby hue and lots of almost confected cherry, plum and berry fruits complemented by vanilla hints. Fine and rounded, a velvety smooth palate bursting with intense and complex flavours.

Château Coufran, Haut-Médoc Cru Bourgeois Supérieur D £31.00
Bordeaux
 This wine has a soft, fleshy and ample feel, combining soft bramble and ripe plum flavours with smooth tannins. Subtle cedar and leaf aromas complete the picture.

Faustino 1 Gran Reserva, Rioja D £28.00
Spain
 The nose is very complex with red berries, cinnamon, clove and oak notes. The palate has a beautiful balance of tannin and acidity with lingering notes of berry fruit and spice on the finish.

Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Domaine Durieu C £35.00
Rhône
 With typical Chateauneuf power, the wine delivers a fresh and spicy nose of red cherry embellished with notes of sage and wild thyme. The palate is equally powerful, with sinuous tannins and huge length.
